**HELP's Eligible School Leavers Program (ESL)** supports youth with disability ready to transition from school into open employment.





**We engage students with disability while they are still at school in a range of activities that supports a person to get ready to look for a job, find a job and keep a job. This is designed to maximise confidence, participation and develop employability skills.**

### **WORKING WITH SCHOOLS**

Our YES team supports students by directly servicing within schools and working with the family/carers and teaching staff. We believe a young person can reach their potential for a fulfilling life through real employment outcomes and with the appropriate support.

### **YOUR JOURNEY WITH ESL**

Once joining HELP's ESL Program, we assist you to:

-  Explore chosen employment options
-  Get prepared for work and job interviews
-  Arrange work experience opportunities (if required)
-  Be referred to a school-based traineeship or apprenticeship OR commence straight into open employment
-  Complete any traineeship modules

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- ✓ Still at school in years 11 or 12
- ✓ Proof of verified disability
- ✓ Not already working more than 8 hours per week
- ✓ Are of legal working age and have a Tax File Number or can obtain one
- ✓ Have a Customer Reference No. (CRN) with DHS or can obtain one
